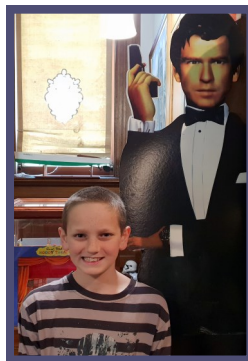


# Blue Mountains Excursion

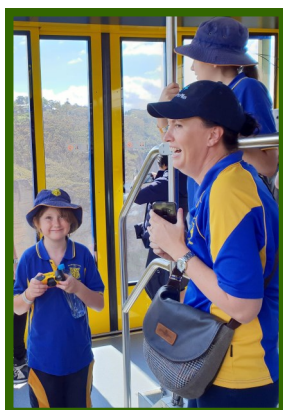
