I would like to close by simply thanking everyone who supported the school throughout the year. It has been a privi-

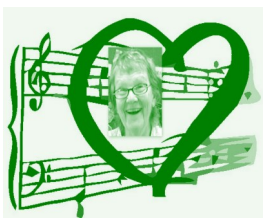
lege to continue working as the principal of our amazing school and I am grateful to everyone; the staff, parents and of course our students for making Hill End Public School such a special place.
