School Leader Report - Claire English

This week we had the STEM Challenge. We made a paper tower first, to get started. Our Hill End team folded the paper into rectangles to make the tower. We put a 200gm weight on the tower. Next we had to make a bottle rocket and at the same time we had to make a protection pod for an egg to drop from a tall height, without it breaking! We had an hour to build these. Our rocket had four fins, a pointy nose cone and tin foil around the outside, to make it look spacey. For the egg challenge we protected the bottom half. We then put a little weight on the bottom dangling from a string. That meant that when it dropped it would not land on the top half, because of the weight pulling it the right way down. We also put a balloon on top to try and slow it down. When all the teams tested their eggs, most of them didn't break, including ours. We the did the bottle rocket testing. We were the first ones up, but when we pulled the string the water leaked out. So while Mr G and Mr Shanahan fixed the launcher we had lunch.

We had hamburgers! When the rocket launcher was fixed we all went down to the playground. Our rocket landed on the target!
