The students have been busy putting the finishing touches to their Portfolios. They are very proud of their work and can't wait to show their families.



There will be a Women's Health clinic next week, 17th December from 10:30am-3:00pm with Kathy from Bathurst Hospital.


These are one on one clinics and very informative so please contact me if you would like more information or would like to book.


