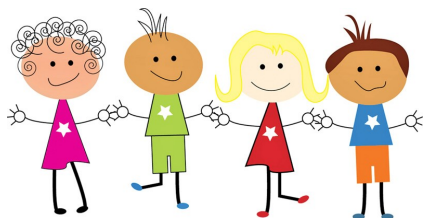
## The Sound of Music

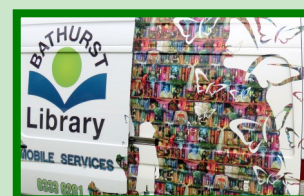

# READY SET WRITE - MY WEEKEND

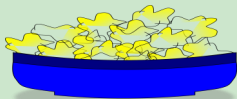

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On the weekend we went to Mudgee in the new ute. Mum got a back massage and Dad looked at a buggy store, we will get one this week or next week.



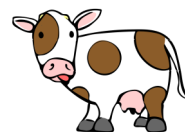
We had KFC for lunch. **Hudson Y2**

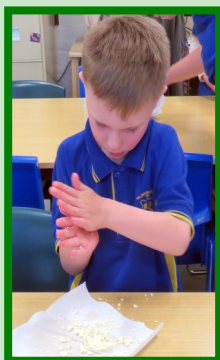


## Term Topic Material World
