On the weekend we went to Cooma and went to Will's play. We played bottle flip with the Adams boys.




## ASSESSMENTS

Mr G and Mrs Rayner have been finishing of assessments for end of 2022 reports. Our students have made excellent gains in their subjects over the past twelve months. Well done!












