PIZZA MAKING













Something interesting was making play doh. Ethan Y1


We have been learning about liquids, solids and gases at school.

Term Topic Material World

We made pizzas as part of our Maths and knowledge based class-room studies. We had finished our Maths topic on mass so measuring our ingredients was a great way to finish off our topic.

As part of our studies on

Chemical world, we used veast to make our own dough for the pizza. When flour, water, sugar and yeast are left in a warm place a chemical reaction occurs, the yeast eats the sugar and starts to undergo a chemical change, called fermenting. The yeast gives off a gas called carbon dioxide. The bubbles get trapped in the pizza dough making it expand. Also the changes in the dough from uncooked to cooked and the melting
