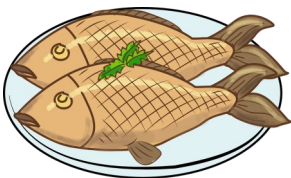

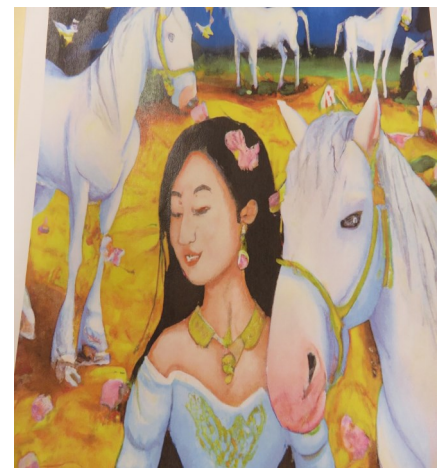

on the horse and went to get the cow. She hopped off and looked around, she looked behind her and saw that the cow was charging at her. She jumped out of the way but the ground gave way under her.

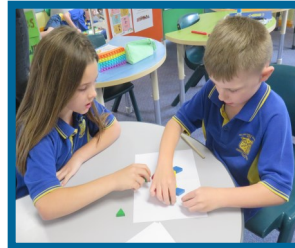
