





The Missing Tracks **By Emily Mobbs**


As Maddy jumped out of bed, she quickly put on her gum boots and ran down the stairs.

hours.


When she finally caught up with them, she jumped off her horse and surprise attacked them, tying her horse to a tree.

Maddy had just closed the gate when she heard her mother calling for her.


"Oh no, not again" Maddy said to herself.
