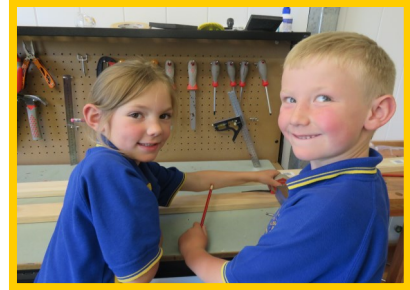


HEPS garden
