The students were amazed at the size of the wind turbines on the recent excursion to the Crudine Wind Farm. The staff at the wind farm explained how the turbines work and how electricity is produced by them. This wind farm produces enough electricity to power 75000 homes which prevents 26600 tonnes of carbon emission annually. The students were happy to see their friends from Glen Alice Public School who were also on the excursion.

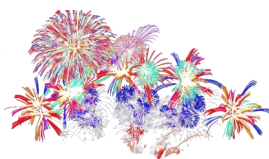

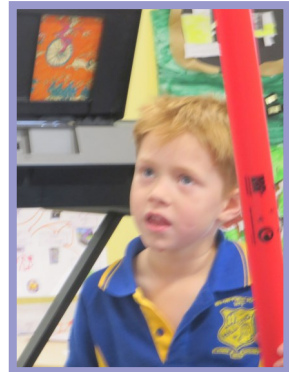
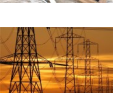
